## **NOTICE OF DEEMED WITHDRAWN POLICY**

To: All Claimants and Claimants' Counsel

Effective February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025, the Owens Corning/Fibreboard Asbestos Personal Injury Trust (the "**Trust**") will enforce a Deemed Withdrawn Policy pursuant to Section 6.3 of the Trust Distribution Procedures ("**TDP**"). The Deemed Withdrawn Policy will apply to deficient claims and claims with a prepetition hold or definite statute of limitations ("**SOL**") hold, as set forth below:

## 1. Deficient Claims

Claims that are Intake or Review Deficient must submit all documents and information necessary for the Trust to approve the claim within six (6) months of (i) the Trust's most recent deficiency notification on Trust Online, or (ii) the date of this Notice, whichever occurs later. If the required action is not taken on the claim within the prescribed time, the claim will be Deemed Withdrawn.

The relevant notification date for purposes of calculating the six-month period is highlighted below.

If the required action is not taken within the prescribed time, the claim will be Deemed Withdrawn.
